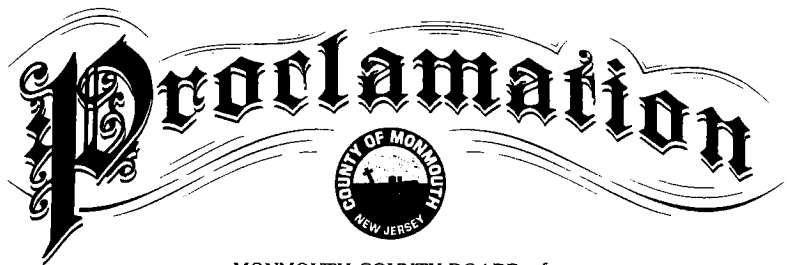


**WORK SESSION AGENDA ITEM #4 – PROCLAMATIONS**
