Future plans for the Trail include linking these two sections of trail and providing a connection to the original, northern section of the Henry Hudson Trail.

**Manasquan River Greenway**

Over 335 acres alongside the Manasquan River in Howell and Freehold Townships are watershed areas protected by the county and available for recreational use. 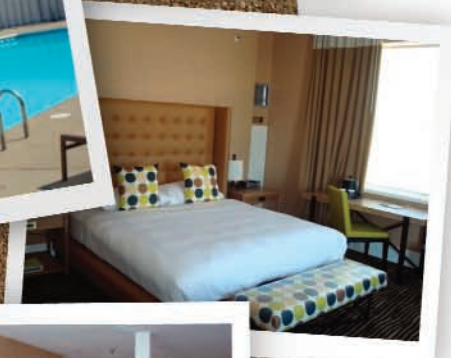

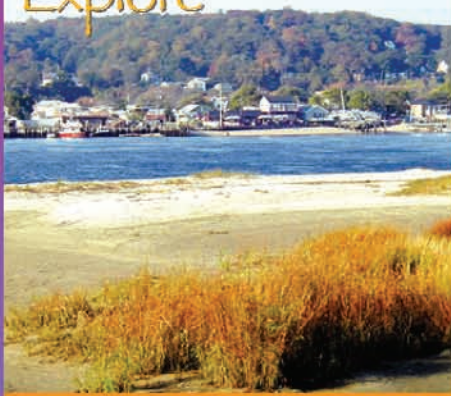

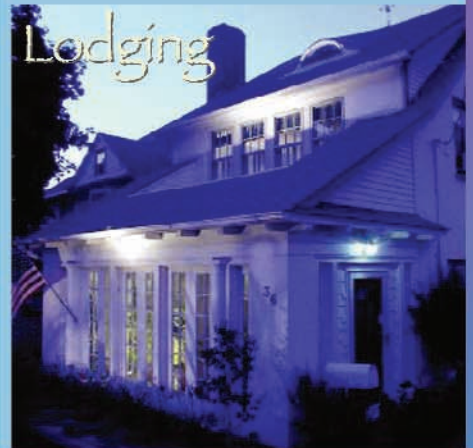

From there, head up to Twin Lights Historic Site for a tour of the Civil War-era lighthouse and the site where Marconi demonstrated the commercial potential of wireless radio by broadcasting the 1899 America's Cup race. Tour the fabulous museum including the new life-saving station exhibit, marvel at the massive Fresnel lens, and climb the steps to the top of the North tower for panoramic views of New York City, Long Island, and the Atlantic Ocean from the highest point on the Eastern Seaboard from south of Maine to Florida.

Near Twin Lights is Hartshorne Woods Park, 736 acres of parkland featuring cabin camping and 11 miles of trails for hiking, biking, horseback riding, and cross country skiing.

Gertrude Ederle Park at the western end of the Highlands Bridge, is named for the Olympic champion swimmer and features beautiful views of the Shrewsbury, Sandy Hook, and Twinlights, as well as Ms. Ederle's favorite roses.

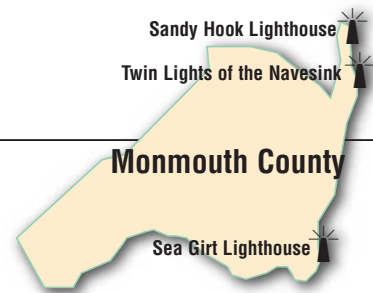

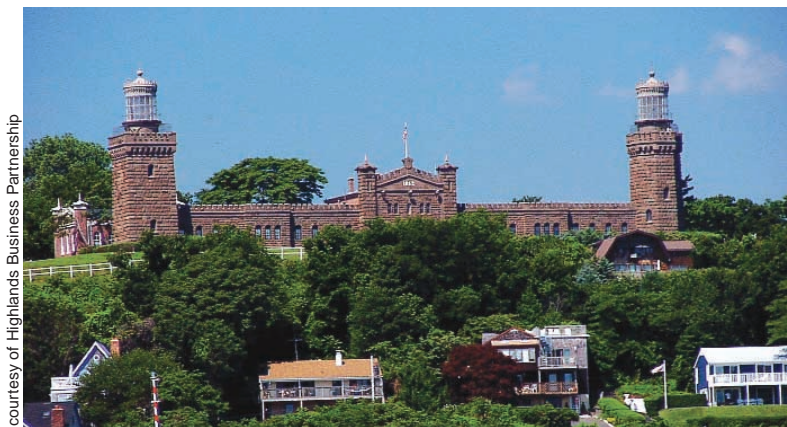

### Twin Lights of the Navesink


