VOTING REQUIREMENTS

To vote in Monmouth County, you must be a United States citizen, you will be 18 years of age by the next election, you will be a resident of the State and County 30 days before the election, and you are NOT currently serving a sentence of incarceration due to a conviction for an indictable offense under any federal or State laws. Registration deadline is 21 days before an election.

REGISTRATION OF VOTERS

Registration of voters shall be conducted at the Office of Commissioner of Registration/ Superintendent of Elections, Monmouth County Special Services Complex, 300 Halls Mill Road, Freehold, each weekday between the hours of 8:30 AM and 4:30 PM, or at the municipal offices in the voter's community each weekday during business hours.

REGISTRATION BY MAIL

Anyone wishing to register by mail may do so by requesting mail registration forms from the Office of Commissioner of Registration/Superintendent of Elections, Monmouth County Special Services Complex, 300 Halls Mill Road, Freehold, New Jersey 07728, or call (732) 431-7780.

ATTENTION VOTERS WHO HAVE MOVED

If you are a registered voter in Monmouth County and have moved within the County, you should submit a change of address with the Commissioner of Registration, 300 Halls Mill Road, Freehold, NJ, 07728 phone #732-431-7780.

If you are a registered voter who has moved within the County, and you did not notify the County Commissioner of Registration of your new address, you will be permitted to vote at this election as follows: (1) Go to the polling place for the election district in which you reside on election day. (2) Tell the District Election Board Member that you are registered to vote but have moved within the County. (3) You will be permitted to vote by provisional ballot. You will need to provide your name, current and old addresses, date of birth and signature on the envelope provided with the ballot. You may call the Commissioner of Registration or your Municipal Clerk to determine your proper polling place location.

NOTE: HAVA (Help America Vote Act) REQUIREMENTS

First-time "Mail-in registrants, voting in a Federal Election **MUST** provide **I.D.** before voting.

Under New Jersey law you have the right to vote in privacy, to have a reasonable amount of time to vote, to receive a replacement ballot if you spoil the first one, and to bring written material into the polling place for your personal use.

A "Voter's Bill of Rights" will be prominently displayed at your polling place. If you believe that your right to vote has been violated in any way, you should immediately notify your county Board of Elections or county Superintendent of Elections.

"Pursuant to provisions of the Voting Accessibility for the Elderly and Handicapped Act of 1984" (Public law 98-435), a telecommunication device for the deaf (TDD) is maintained at the Election Division, Department of State, Trenton, New Jersey.

COUNTY PUBLIC QUESTIONS

Should the County of Monmouth increase its dedication to the Monmouth County Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, and Farmland and Historic Preservation Trust Fund from the previously approved and implemented annual levy of 2.75 cents per \$100 of equalized valuation to 3.75 cents per \$100 of equalized valuation, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:12-15.2(e), with the annual levy to be used for any or all of the purposes set forth in N.J.S.A. 40: 12-15.2(a)(l)?

This proposition would approve an increase in the annual collection rate from 2.75 cents per \$100 of equalized valuation to 3.75 cents per \$100 of equalized valuation through which the County of Monmouth funds the Monmouth County Open Space Trust Fund. The Open Space Trust Fund supports the current program to acquire and preserve open space for County park and recreation

areas, to conserve natural resources and to protect water quality, to develop and maintain the system of County public recreation, which includes those County lands acquired for recreation and conservation purposes, to acquire easements to preserve County farmland, and to participate in cooperative park and recreation projects with Monmouth County municipalities, thereby permanently preserving these areas, providing recreational opportunities, conserving natural resources and protecting water quality for future generations of Monmouth County residents. Increasing the rate will enable the funding for open space acquisition to keep pace with rising land costs and with the loss of land to development.

MUNICIPAL PUBLIC QUESTIONS

Bradley Beach Borough

Municipal Question

Charter Commission

Shall the COUNCIL-MANAGER PLAN of the Optional Municipal Charter Law, providing for FIVE (5) council members to be ELECTED AT-LARGE for STAGGERED terms at NONPARTISAN elections to be held in NOVEMBER, with the MAYOR ELECTED DIRECTLY BY THE VOTERS, be adopted by the Borough of Bradley Beach?

Explanatory Statement

The voters of Bradley Beach are asked whether to approve a change to Bradley Beach's form of government from the Small Municipality form to the Council-Manager form under the Optional Municipal Charter Law, commonly known as the Faulkner Act.

If approved, Bradley Beach will be governed by a council of five (5) members, which includes a directly-elected Mayor. The Mayor serves as a voting member of the Council and only possesses limited appointment powers including to the library board of trustees. The Council as a body possesses the Borough's legislative powers and shall determine all matters of policy for Bradley Beach. The Council shall appoint a Municipal Manager, who will exercise all executive and administrative powers. The Municipal Manager shall serve at the will of the Council, subject to removal by a simple majority vote. This contrasts with the current Small Municipality form, in which the Mayor possesses the executive powers including all appointments and the position of Borough Administrator is optional.

The Mayor will be directly elected by the voters for a term of four (4) years. The remainder of the Council members will be elected for staggered terms of four (4) years each. In order to initiate staggered terms, three (3) of the council members elected under the new form of government shall serve for only two (2) years, to be determined by lot at the organization meeting of the first Council. The remaining one (1) Council member and Mayor would serve an initial four (4) year term, with a municipal election held every two (2) years.

The council shall be elected at-large through nonpartisan elections held at the November general election.

If the change of government is approved by the voters, the first municipal election will be held on November 3, 2026, and the new Mayor and Council members will be installed on January 1, 2027.

Little Silver Borough

Municipal Question

Open Space

Should the Borough of Little Silver increase the annual levy for the Municipal Open Space, Recreation, and Farmland and Historic Preservation Trust Fund from the amount of \$0.01 per \$100 to the amount of \$0.015 per \$100 of assessed valuation of real property?

Explanatory Statement

The proposed referendum seeks to increase the dedicated Municipal Open Space, Recreation, and Farmland and Historic Preservation Trust Fund levy from the current \$0.01 to \$0.015 per \$100 of assessed valuation. The increase is being proposed to provide for additional funds to afford the Borough the ability to acquire, develop, and maintain additional land, easements and development rights for open space, recreation, and farmland and historic preservation purposes, including costs and expenses associated therewith.

For an average home assessed at \$1,146,935, this would increase the tax payment from \$114.69 per year to \$172.04 per year.

Manasquan Borough

Municipal Question

Open Space

Shall the Borough Council of the Borough of Manasquan, County of Monmouth adopt an Ordinance amending the "Municipal Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, and Farmland and Historic Preservation Trust Fund" to increase the rate of the annual levy, from the current maximum of one-half (\$0.005) cents per ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) of assessed valuation, to two and one-half (\$0.025) cents per ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) of assessed valuation for the purposes of:

- (a) Acquisition of lands for recreation and conservation purposes;
- (b) Development of lands acquired for recreation and conservation purposes;
- (c) Maintenance of lands acquired for recreation and conservation purposes;
- (d) Historic preservation of Historic properties, structures, facilities, site, area or objects and acquisition of such properties, structures, facilities, sites, areas or objects for Historic preservation purposes; and
- (e) Payment of debt service on indebtedness issued or incurred by the Borough of Manasquan for any of these purposes;
- (f) Blue Acres Projects.

Interpretive Statement

A "yes" vote for this proposition means that you do want the Borough of Manasquan to take the necessary steps to amend the "Municipal Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, and Farmland and Historic Preservation Trust Fund" to increase the rate of the annual levy, from the current maximum of one-half (\$0.005) cents per ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100) of assessed valuation, to two and one-half (\$0.025) cents per ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100) of assessed valuation that shall be used to acquire lands for recreation and conservation purposes. The Trust Fund can also be used to develop or maintain lands that are acquired for recreation and conservation purposes or used for the acquisition or Historic preservation of historic properties, structures, facilities, sites, areas or objects located within the Borough of Manasquan. The Trust Fund can also

be used for Blue Acre Projects to acquire flood-prone properties. The Trust Fund can also be used to make payments on bonds issued for any of these purposes. If approved, the increase from the current maximum of one-half (\$0.005) cents per ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100) of assessed valuation, to two and one-half (\$0.025) cents per ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100) of assessed valuation will result in the annual increase of \$132.37 in the municipal portion of the real property taxes assessed on a home with an assessment of \$661,862.70, the Borough average assessment, and based upon the current total assessed valuations of property within the Borough, would raise approximately \$423,167.72 of additional funds annually for the "Municipal Open Space, Recreation, Floodplain Protection, and Farmland and Historic Preservation Trust Fund".

Ocean Township

Municipal Question

Should the Township of Ocean combine the Township of Ocean Planning Board and Township of Ocean Zoning Board of Adjustment into a Joint Land Use Board?

Interpretive Statement

A vote of Yes will dissolve the Planning Board and the Zoning Board of Adjustment and will consolidate their functions into a single Joint Land Use Board. A vote of No will keep the present Boards as they currently exist.

Roosevelt Borough

Municipal Question

Shall Bond Ordinance No. 2024-09 of the Borough Council of the Borough of Roosevelt, adopted on September 4, 2025, entitled: "Bond Ordinance Providing for the Franklin Delano Roosevelt Amphitheater Project, Appropriating \$710,000 Therefor and Authorizing the Issuance of \$676,000 Bonds and Notes to Finance a Portion of the Costs Thereof, Authorized in and by the Borough of Roosevelt, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey" be ratified?

Interpretive Statement

Bond Ordinance No. 2024-09 relates to the construction of certain improvements to the Borough's Franklin Delano Roosevelt Amphitheater with a total authorized appropriation of \$710,000 for the project, of which total amount, the Borough may be later reimbursed up to \$330,000 by a Monmouth County Open Space Grant, subject to the terms and conditions of said grant agreement. A vote of "Yes" will authorize funding the construction of certain improvements to the Borough's Franklin Delano Roosevelt Amphitheater. A vote of "No" will decline funding the construction of certain improvements to the Borough's Franklin Delano Roosevelt Amphitheater.

SCHOOL PUBLIC QUESTIONS

Marlboro Board of Education

Bond Proposal Question

The Board of Education of the Township of Marlboro in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Board") is authorized to (a) undertake various HVAC improvements, upgrades, and renovations at Asher Holmes Elementary School and Robertsville Elementary School, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, equipment, and any site work; (b) appropriate \$5,345,031 for such improvements; and (c) issue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$5,345,031.

The final eligible costs for the projects approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education are \$5,345,031 (consisting of \$2,550,717 for Asher Holmes Elementary School and \$2,794,314 for Robertsville Elementary School). The projects include \$0 for school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects. The State debt service aid is contingent upon the passing of this Bond Proposal Question. The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this election. Do you approve this Bond Proposal Question?
