THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS MUST BE SUBMITTED TO BE APPROVED AS A BODY ART PRACTICIONER

- Documentation and verification of the completion of an apprenticeship with a minimum of 2,000 for tattooing (8:27-7.1) and 1000 hours for body piercing (8:27-6.1).
 1. Daily log books signed and dated by apprentice and supervising practitioner.
 2. Any signed testaments from any previous employers regarding apprenticeship hours will require verification from the local health department in which previous employers body art establishment resides.
 3. Tax records.
 4. Certificates of course completion or memberships in professional organizations recognized by the New Jersey Department of Health.
- 10 original tattoo photographs performed by the tattooist/ body piercer during apprenticeship.
- 3 signed testaments from previous clients.
- Provide evidence of completion of an approved bloodborne pathogen course.
- 29 CFR 1910.1030 requires employers to ensure that all medical evaluations and procedures including the hepatitis B vaccine and vaccination series and post-exposure evaluation and follow-up, including prophylaxis, are made available at no cost to the employee. If the hepatitis B vaccination has been declined, provide the completed and signed Appendix A to Section 1910.1030 - Hepatitis B Vaccine Declination.
