

Free Narcan available at the Monmouth County Department of Health and Human Services

According to [Provisional data](#) released by the CDC's National Vital Statistics System "a 26.9% decrease in drug overdose deaths nationwide in 2024, falling from 110,037 in 2023 to 80,391. The decline represents an estimated average of 81 fewer overdose deaths per day."

One of the contributing factors has been the widespread use of naloxone (Narcan) the overdose reversal drug.
