

Please take notice that the Monmouth County Board of Health will consider adoption and hold a public hearing of the ordinance identified below at its regularly scheduled meeting on May 16, 2017 at 7:00 pm at the Board of Health's offices located at 3435 U.S. 9, Freehold, NJ 07728:

An Ordinance titled: "Establishing Approval & Inspection Requirements for Construction, Alteration, Testing and Use of Public Non-Community and Non-Public Wells and water Supply Systems within the Jurisdiction of the Monmouth County Board of Health." This ordinance allow the Monmouth County Health Department ("MCHD"), to protect the public non-community and non-public drinking water supplies of its Constituent Municipalities by requiring MCHD approval of plans to construct or alter any water supply as defined in the ordinance prior to drilling or commencing any alteration. This ordinance requires the issuance of a Certificate of Compliance upon the permit holder's satisfactory completion of all requirements as set forth herein. A copy of the ordinance is available for review and inspection on the Monmouth County Board of Health's website and it is on file with the Board of Health during its regularly scheduled business hours at the address above.
