

Effective May 22, the following interim changes will be made at Monmouth County Park System Golf Courses:

1. Tee time intervals will continue to be spaced 16 minutes apart and limited to four golfers per tee time. In an effort to allow more players the opportunity to reserve a tee time, reservations will be for a maximum of two players per day. Singles will continue to be able to make tee time reservations as well.
2. Pre-paid online bookings will no longer be available. In lieu of pre-paid bookings, the tee time reservation system will require a credit card to be placed on file to make a reservation. This credit card will then be charged the day of play upon check-in with the starter. Please arrive 10-minutes early to make payment. If any golf cardholders would like to add a credit card to their account ahead of time, you can do so after logging into the reservation system under "My Account → Billing → Manage Payment Methods → Add Credit Card". Please do not add money to your account as this will need to be refunded. **Only the credit card information is required.**

3. Electric golf cart rentals will be available on a first tee time, first served basis and limited to single occupants only. As per the executive order, immediate family members are able to share a golf cart. Push/pull hand cart rentals will also now be available. Payment will be required on the day of play immediately before your tee time by calling the golf center upon your arrival or when checking in with the starter.
4. Greens fees and miscellaneous charges will return to the usual applicable adopted fees and charges. Golfers will need to present their golf ID card or key fob number at check-in to get the applicable rates. ID cards should be purchased in advance to facilitate timely processing of transactions at check-in. No other discounted rates (ie, matinee, 9-hole plus) or other specials will currently be available.
5. The golf center buildings, except restroom facilities, will continue to be closed to the public. Purchases will be made over the phone or via the starter at the golf course. Face coverings are required in restrooms.

6. The golf courses will not offer rental clubs, water coolers, bunker rakes, ball washers, or benches. No tee markers will be on the golf course and inserts will be placed inside putting green cups to make golf balls easily retrievable without removing the flagstick.
7. FootGolf courses at Bel-Aire and Pine Brook remain closed to the public.
8. Advance tee time reservations will continue to be limited to 2 days in advance for all cardholders. Golfer shall cancel or modify any reservations through the tee time reservation system at least 12 hours prior to their tee time to avoid a no show penalty. The golf centers will not be able to cancel reservations over the phone. The resident golf cardholder loyalty point accrual will unfortunately continue to be temporarily suspended.
9. Golf card sales are currently available via the golf centers. Please call them prior to going to the golf courses. Currently there is no online option available.
10. All driving ranges, putting greens, practice areas, and the short game area at Charleston Springs will reopen effective 7 a.m. on Tuesday, May 26, with limited occupancies.
