Welcome to Fort Monmouth Recreation Area

This 10 acre site was taken over by the county in 2013, a few years after the military base at Fort Monmouth closed. It was formerly used by the US Army as a youth center, providing activities and afterschool programs for service member's families.



Conveniently located off Parkway Exit 105, "The Fort" has an impressive array of facilities, including a large outdoor pool, classrooms, gym and game room. It's the perfect site for arts & crafts, sports, exercise classes, club meetings and children's parties/special events.

Recreation Facilities

The Fort Monmouth Recreation Center features tailored spaces and equipment for just about any type of recreational activity you can imagine:

- Fitness room for pilates, yoga, dance and aerobic classes
- Program rooms for classes or parties
- Gym with bleacher seating for full-court basketball/volleyball, pickleball and tennis
- Game area with pool tables, air hockey, ping pong and foosball
- Professional kitchen for cooking/baking classes
- Outdoor sport court

The recreation center has four spacious program rooms (21'x40') for activities including a designated pre-school room, art room and two general use rooms for school age and adult programs. Two of these rooms are available for rental; each can accommodate up to 40 people for a party or meeting.

Arena Gymnasium/Rentals

The multi-purpose, 5,700 sq. ft. gym has six adjustable basketball hoops (for full and half court games) and bleacher seating. It is currently used for open play and sports programs, but can also be rented for leagues and team practices.



The Pool 848-456-4278, ext. 1

Fort Monmouth has a 144,000 gallon, 3,500 sq. ft. swimming pool with a pool house with changing rooms and restrooms. Used for camps and water-based exercise classes, the pool also hosts open swim.



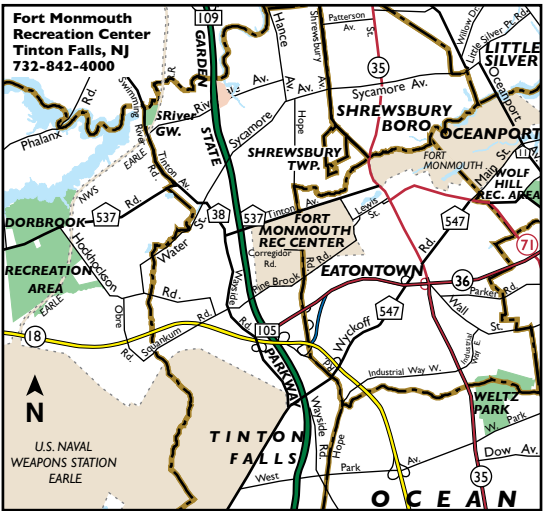

Park Hours

Fort Monmouth Recreation Center is open most weekdays from 7 a.m. - 8 p.m., and weekends from 8 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. (closing time varies, please call).

Preventing Tick Bites

To avoid contact with ticks that may cause illness wear light-colored clothes, long sleeves and pants (tucked into socks); use insect repellent; walk in the center of trails; stay away from tall grass, shrubby/brushy areas and leaf litter; check yourself for ticks during and after park visits; and shower soon after being outdoors. From GS Parkway North, Exit 105. Bear left, follow signs for Rt. 36 East/Long Branch. At first light, turn left onto Hope Rd. (north). Go straight through next light (crossing over Rt. 36) and follow Hope Rd. for about 0.5 miles through light at Pinebrook Rd. and across RR tracks. At next light, turn left onto Corregidor Rd. Fort entrance is on the left.

From GS Parkway South, Exit 105. Follow signs for Fort Monmouth/Tinton Falls, bear right. After first light, take jughandle right onto Hope Rd. (north). Go straight through next light (crossing over Rt. 36) and follow Hope Rd. for about 0.5 miles through light at Pinebrook Rd. and across RR tracks. At next light, turn left onto Corregidor Rd. Fort entrance is on the left.
