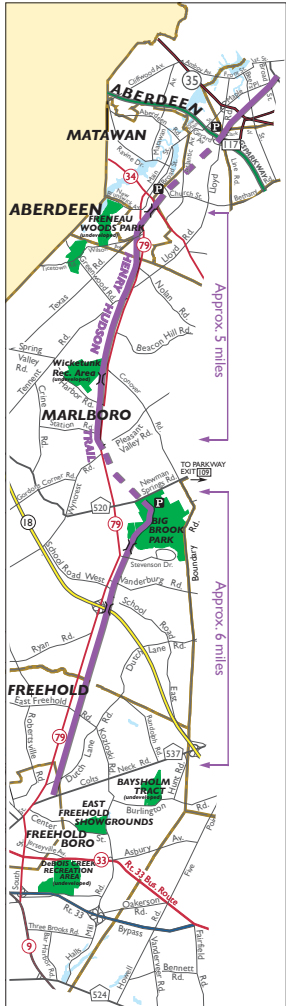

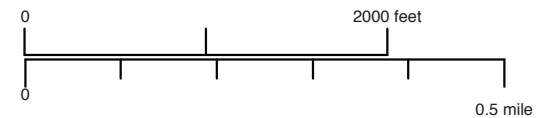
Henry Hudson Trail (HHT)

About This Park

Big Brook Park is a mosaic of habitats, the most significant of which is the extensive grassland covering the rolling landscape. Abundant birds, butterflies, and insects use these fields. Many field edges are mowed, providing unmarked trail experiences.

Trail Information

Approx. 1.0 mile (1.6km) of the paved Henry Hudson Trail (HHT) runs through this park (inside property line). The HHT continues southward outside the park for another 5.0 miles (8.0km) into Freehold.

Please obey the rules of protocol for right of way on the trails; bicyclists yield to all other trail users, and pedestrians yield to equestrians. Stay on the marked or mowed trails, plan your route, take a trail map with you, and wear appropriate safety gear. At a



brisk pace, it takes approximately 20 minutes to walk 1 mile (1.6km). Portions of this park may be open for deer hunting from October to February.
