

Seven Presidents Skateplex Use Guidelines

All Monmouth County Park System Rules and Regulations shall apply plus the following supplemental guidelines governing the facilities at Seven Presidents Skateplex.

There is an inherent risk associated with the use of the **Skateplex**. Users of skateparks, by participation, accept the risks inherent in such participation of which the ordinary prudent person is or should be aware.

1. The **Skateplex** facility is open during posted hours of operation. There may be times programs may limit the use of the **Skateplex** facilities as well as during times of maintenance and repairs.
2. The **Skatepark** area is for skateboarders and in-line skates. All other equipment is prohibited from all facilities. Non-users are not permitted within the **Skatepark** unless directly assisting a child under eight (8) years of age.
3. All users must skate responsibly and avoid collisions with other users.
4. Use of drugs, alcohol, profanity or abusive language and vandalism is prohibited.
5. For safety reasons, all facilities will be limited to the posted established maximum capacities. All users must abide by the decisions of the Park Rangers / Skate attendant.
6. No food, drink, tobacco products, or pets are permitted in the **Skatepark** or **Skaterink**.
7. For the safety of its users, facility use is not permitted when equipment or its surface is wet and/or icy.
8. No one under the age of eight is permitted in the **Skatepark** or **Skaterink** without adult supervision.
9. Only individual listening devices are permitted in the **Skatepark**.
10. No personal ramps, rails, boxes or other jump equipment/materials will be allowed. Adjusting, moving or altering existing equipment is prohibited.
11. The staff reserves the right to eject anyone at anytime for inappropriate behavior.
12. An ANSI or SNELL approved helmet must be worn at all times while in the **Skatepark**. Elbow pads, kneepads, and wrist guards are recommended for use of the **Skatepark** facilities.

13. It is recommended to wear all available Protective Equipment while using the **Skaterink**; including an approved helmet, elbow and kneepads, and wrist guards.
14. The **Skaterink** is for in-line skates only.

Note: Employees of the Board of Recreation Commissioners are vested with police authority and empowered to make arrests for violations of the County Park rules and regulations. Rules applying to special conditions or situations within an individual county park or recreation area may be considered supplemental. These rules and regulations are promulgated in accordance with provisions of the New Jersey Revised Statutes Title 40, Chapter 12-6 which reads as follows:

“The Board of Recreation Commissioners shall have full control over all lands, playgrounds, and recreation places acquired or leased under the provisions of Section 40: 12-1 to 40: 12-9 of this title and may adopt suitable Rules, Regulations, and By-Laws for the use thereof and the conduct of all persons while on or using the same, and any person who shall violate any of such Rules, Regulations, or By-Laws shall be deemed and adjudged to be a disorderly person”.
