	Some dogs have a propensity to behave in ways, which may result in injury to members or other persons in the immediate vicinity due to instinctive actions or provoked behaviors;
	Dogs may react in an unpredictable way to unfamiliar environments, sounds, strange odors, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals;
	4-H members are to listen to adult volunteers when working with their dogs in group settings and when around other dogs and 4-H members;
	Other 4-H members involved in the 4-H Dog Project may fail to maintain control of their dog or fail to act within their abilities, thus causing harm to my/our child/ward, my child/ward's volunteers, or spectators;
	Other participants in an activity, event, or program may act in a negligent manner which otherwise may result in harm to my/our child/ward and/or their dog; and
	If a dog that my/our child/ward is using for a 4-H project has been or becomes aggressive towards other people (youth and adults) when not provoked, my/our child/ward may not use this dog for a 4-H project.
