Delaware River Odyssey Gear Requirements

REQUIRED DAILY GEAR

Please pack all daily gear in a small dry bag (provided):

- Lunch and snacks (provide own lunch for Monday)
- Refillable, non-breakable water bottle
- Rain jacket or poncho
- Sunscreen and insect repellant (non-aerosol)
- Long sleeve or fleece shirt
- Hat with brim
- Non-cotton layers (rashguard or Under Armour) for water activities
- Water shoes; must be closed-toe and closed-heel (old sneakers work best)

REQUIRED OVERNIGHT GEAR

- Long pants (1)
- T-shirts (3-4)
- Long sleeve shirt, non-cotton (1)
- Shorts (2)
- Swimsuits (2) Must be properly fitted with appropriate coverage
 - ► Nylon shorts are great for protecting from hot canoe seats
- Towel and small river towel
- Extra underwear and socks (as needed)
- Reusable, non-breakable plate, mug, spoon and fork (No Glass)
- Small flashlight with extra batteries (headlamps work best)
- Sweatshirt or lightweight jacket for those cool summer evenings
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, deoderant, extra contacts, brush, etc.)
 - ► Pack these in a Ziploc bag so you can easily put "smell-ables" away at night
- Pajamas

SUGGESTED ADDITIONAL GEAR

- Inexpensive/disposable camera
- Sunglasses with retainer strap
- Sandals/flip-flops to be worn at camp to air out feet
- Journal and/or book
- Deck of cards

What is a "smell-able"? Anything that has an odor in it that might interest wild critters. Food, toiletries and the shirt you spilled your dinner on are all considered "smell-ables".
