CAMP INFORMATION

DROP-OFF/PICK-UP

Please drop off your child at Historic Longstreet Farm approximately 10 minutes before the start of camp to ensure proper check in. Each day campers will need to be signed in and out. Campers cannot be released to anyone not listed on the Parent Pick Up list. A valid photo ID is required by all authorized individuals at the time of pick up. Campers should be picked up promptly at the end of camp.

CAMP HOURS

- Domestic Traditions: Monday-Thursday from 12-4 p.m.
- Down on the Farm: Monday-Friday from 9:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m. (with the exception of the week of July 1-5 when there is no camp on Thursday, July 4)
- Life on the Farm
 - ► Monday-Wednesday from 9:30 a.m.-2:30 p.m.
 - On Thursday, this camp will dismiss at 8 p.m.
- Pulleys, Pumps and Hand Power: Monday-Thursday from 12-4 p.m.
- Turn of the Century Cooking: Monday-Thursday from 12-4 p.m.
- Youngster Hayseed Adventures: Monday-Friday from 9 a.m.-2 p.m. (with the exception of the week of July 1-5 when there is no camp on Thursday, July 4)

REQUIRED FOR CAMP PARTICIPATION

- Campers are to wear closed-toe shoes, sneakers are best.
- Please have your child apply sunscreen and bug spray before arriving.
- Bring a backpack with the following items, marked with your child's name, inside:
 - ► Refillable water bottle
 - ► Sunscreen
 - ► Towel to sit on
 - Camps starting in the morning should bring lunch, drinks and snack. Camps starting in the afternoon should bring a snack and drink. Food should be packed with cooling packs.

DO NOT BRING TO CAMP

- Any foods containing nuts, nut oils, or nut byproducts
- Valuable items or electronics the Park System cannot be held responsible for lost or stolen items

INCLEMENT WEATHER

If at any time you are unsure as to whether your camp will be held, please call the Weather Cancellation Number at 732-842-4000, ext. 6. A recorded message will be in place at least ONE HOUR prior to your camp's starting time. If your camp is not listed on the message, it is running as scheduled.
