Camp Hours:

Youngster Hayseeds Adventure camps will run from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM, Monday-Friday

Down on the Farm Camps will run from 9:30 AM to 12:30 PM, Monday-Friday;

Life on the Farm Camps will run from 9:30 AM to 12:30 PM, Monday-Friday;

On Thursday, this camp will meet from 12:30 PM to 7:30 PM

Domestic Traditions will run from 1 PM-4 PM, Monday-Thursday

All camps will have a scheduled break for drinks, snacks and bathroom use.

What to Bring:

Camp participants should bring water, sunscreen, and a snack. Some of our activities and breaks will take place on the grass; we encourage our campers to bring their own towel for sitting. Participants need to also wear proper footwear- close-toed shoes/ sneakers, or any shoe that stays comfortably on their foot are recommended, flip-flops and sandals should not be worn. All campers need to bring a face mask or face covering.

Drop-Off/Pick Up:

Camp participants should arrive to camp at least 10 minutes before the start of camp to ensure proper registration. We will meet at the Longstreet Farm Visitor Center for both check in and check out. Each camper must be signed in and signed out. No camper will be allowed to leave with someone who is not listed on their PICK-UP AUTHORIZATION FORM. Photo identification required. If someone not listed on your PICK-UP AUTHORIZATION FORM will be picking up your camper, you will need to provide written authorization to release the camper to the designated individual.

Release Form and Medical Information Sheet:

The completed camp form packet and special accommodation forms, if need, must be completed and returned prior to attending camp. **No camper will be admitted without a completed packet.** Forms can be found at www.monmouthcountyparks.com.

Inclement Weather:

Camp staff will personally call each participant One Hour prior to the camp's starting time if camp will be cancelled. If at any time you are unsure as to whether your camp will be held you may also call the Farm office at 732-946-3758.
