Odyssey Adventures Overnight Gear Requirements

Prepare for an awesome trip! Make sure you arrive with both your daily gear and your overnight gear. Please see your camp's weekly schedule to determine how long your overnight camp will be.

The Park System can provide a duffel bag, sleeping bag, and sleeping pad for all campers. If you have your own, feel free to use that instead.

REQUIRED OVERNIGHT GEAR

Please make sure everything fits into the duffel bag:

- Reusable, non-breakable plate, mug, spoon and fork
- Small flashlight with extra batteries (headlamps work best)
- Sweatshirt or lightweight jacket for those cool summer evenings
- Toiletries (soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, extra contacts, brush, etc.)
 - ▶ Pack these in a separate container so you can easily put "smell-ables" away at night
- Pajamas
- Extra underwear and socks
- Small towel
- Clothes for the next day(s)
 - ▶ Will vary based upon activity

What is a "smell-able"?
Anything that has an odor in it that might interest wild critters. Food, toiletries and the shirt you spilled your dinner on are all considered "smell-ables".

OTHER SUGGESTED GEAR

- If it is extremely hot, bring a sheet; it's a great way to keep cool while sleeping
- Deck of cards or other card game
- A book
- Small pillow, if needed
