Outdoor Adventures Information and Tips:

- Face coverings are required for all Odyssey Adventure Camps.
- Photo I.D. Required for Camper Pick-up
- Campers must bring a properly fitted bicycle helmet that complies with the U.S. CPSC Safety Standards for Bicycle Helmets. The CPSC label is located inside the helmet. Campers will not be permitted to wear helmets without this label.
- Campers must bring a properly fitted two-wheel bicycle with gears that is in good working condition. Campers should be comfortable with the bicycle and in control of it when riding.
- Always be prepared! Look at the camper handbook for the list of required gear. Gear will vary based upon activity.
- Camp may be cancelled due to inclement weather. Check at (732) 842-4000 ext. 6.
