


Rockin' the Trails 2024



Rockin' the Trails at the Monmouth County Parks



Here's how it works

1. Visit the nine parks listed in this brochure from **April 1 - December 31, 2024**.
2. Follow the trail or instructions indicated in the brochure to locate the bridge, fence or other structure that the Rockin' the Trails marker is attached to.
3. Write down the fossil name in this brochure under the appropriate park.
4. Did you see any wildlife today?
5. Mail your completed brochure to the Huber Woods Environmental Center to be entered in the Grand Prize Drawing.
6. OR bring your completed brochure to the Huber Woods Environmental Center to receive a small prize and be entered in the Grand Prize Drawing.
7. There is no cost for participating and you may complete the hunt at your own pace.
8. Please submit your completed brochures by **December 31, 2024**.

1. Big Brook Park

521 County Rd 520, Marlboro, NJ 07746

Starting from the Boundary Rd Lot, make your way towards the Big Brook waters.

Did you see any wildlife today?

2. Fisherman’s Cove Conservation Area

391 Third Avenue, Manasquan, NJ 08736

From the parking lot, venture into the maritime forest and keep an eye out for an ancient cousin of the octopus.

Did you see any wildlife today?

3. Freneau Woods Park

360 Monastery Lane, Aberdeen, NJ 07747

Journey to Inspiration Point and see if you can locate this impressive megafauna.

Did you see any wildlife today?

4. Holmdel Park

44 Longstreet Rd, Holmdel, NJ 07733

From the Ramanessin Lot, begin the Steeplechase Trail and head east.

Did you see any wildlife today?

5. Huber Woods Environmental Center

25 Browns Dock Rd, Locust, NJ 07760

Head to the Timolat section, and pay close attention to the Sycamore trees by the pond.

Did you see any wildlife today?

6. Manasquan Reservoir Environmental Center

331 Georgia Tavern Rd, Howell, NJ 07731

Take the Perimeter Trail towards Milepost 1, see if you can spot this fossil ready to come out of its shell.

Did you see any wildlife today?

7. Perrineville Lake Park

21 Aggress Rd, Millstone, NJ 08535

Explore the lakeside loop, searching for this fierce predator of the Late Cretaceous period.

Did you see any wildlife today?

8. Shark River Park

1101 Schoolhouse Rd, Wall, NJ 07753

Trek on the Bridge Loop in a clockwise direction, starting from the bridge. Keep an eye out for this living fossil.

9. Tatum Park

144 Holland Rd, Middletown, NJ 07748

Head South on Meadow Run and see if you can spot this prehistoric swimmer.
