CAMP INFORMATION

Camp information should be completed through the ePACT Network and submitted to the Monmouth County Park System. Please watch for an email invite from Monmouth County Park System via ePACT Network to create your account. If you attended camp with us last year and you have an account, please watch for an email to review and update your account information.

Camp information, as well as special accommodation forms (if needed), must be completed and returned prior to attending camp. If you have questions regarding camp forms, please visit www.MonmouthCountyParks.com and click on "Camp Forms", or call 732 842-4000, ext. 4312.

DROP-OFF/PICK-UP

Please drop off your child at the location specified on your permit; see the Dorbrook Summer Camp Map meeting locations. Many camps begin at the same time, so please bring your permit with you on the first day. Staff arrives 15 minutes before your camp's start time. Each day campers will need to be signed in and out. Campers cannot be released to anyone not listed on the Parent Pick Up list. A valid photo ID is required by all authorized individuals at the time of pick up. Campers should be picked up promptly at the end of camp.

REQUIRED FOR CAMP PARTICIPATION

- Campers are to wear closed-toe shoes; sneakers are best.
- Water bottle
- Sunscreen and/or a hat
- Snack and drink for half-day camps; snack, drinks and lunch for full-day camps (children are not permitted to use snack or soda machines)
- Wear or bring a bathing suit and towel each day. All camps do not swim every day, but we may use sprinklers, water games, or possibly the Sprayground on very hot days.
- Campers may bring their own equipment for single-sport camps if they so choose
- Most campers use backpacks to keep their belongings together
- Please mark all items with your child's name

DO NOT BRING TO CAMP

- Any foods containing nuts, nut oils, or nut byproducts
- Personal items, including toys and electronics - the Park System cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items

INCLEMENT WEATHER

If at any time you are unsure as to whether your camp will be held, please call the Weather Cancellation Number at 732-842-4000, ext. 6. A recorded message will be in place at least ONE HOUR prior to your camp's starting time. If your camp is not listed on the message, it is running as scheduled.
