CAMP INFORMATION

Camp information should be completed through the ePACT Network and submitted to the Monmouth County Park System. Please watch for an email invite from Monmouth County Park System via ePACT Network to create your account. If you attended camp with us last year and you have an account, please watch for an email to review and update your account information.

DROP-OFF/PICK-UP

Please drop off your child at the Dorbrook Recreation Area "Purple Tent". Drop-off begins at 8:45 a.m. every morning, with the exception of children enrolled in before care. Each day campers will need to be signed in and out. Campers cannot be released to anyone not listed on the Parent Pick Up list. A valid photo ID is required by all authorized individuals at the time of pick up. Campers should be picked up promptly at the end of camp.

Please Note: We remind parents that their child may miss out on some camp activities by arriving late or leaving early. We do not offer make-up activities in such cases.

REQUIRED FOR CAMP PARTICIPATION

- Campers are to wear closed-toe sneakers and play clothes that can get messy.
- Bring a backpack with the following items, marked with your child's name, inside:
 - ▶ Refillable water bottle
 - ▶ Face mask, if needed
 - ▶ Sunscreen
 - ▶ Snack and lunch
 - ▶ Change of clothes, bathing suit and towel
- *Please Note: On My Own campers do not need lunch, bathing suits, or towels. Only a snack, water bottle, sunscreen and face mask (if needed).*

DO NOT BRING TO CAMP

- Any foods containing nuts, nut oils, or nut byproducts
- Valuable items or electronics - the Park System cannot be held responsible for lost or stolen items

POOL INFORMATION

Our youth pool is 48" deep; our main pool is 2'-5', with a lazy "T" that goes to 3-7'. Campers must pass a swim test to be allowed past the 3' section. Lifeguards are on duty and counselors play and swim with the campers. **On My Own campers do not use the pool.**

FIELD TRIP

Maple Sapling and Oak Tree campers will go on a field trip for one day during their camp week. Destinations will be shared as we approach your summer camp date. We will travel together in our 15-passenger van driven by a licensed CDL driver. Please Note: You may be asked to send your child with no more than \$10.00 cash for ice cream, entrance fees, etc.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

If at any time you are unsure as to whether your camp will be held, please call the Weather Cancellation Number at 732-842-4000, ext. 6. A recorded message will be in place at least ONE HOUR prior to your camp's starting time. If your camp is not listed on the message, it is running as scheduled.
