



Therapeutic Recreation Camps

The following is a list of upcoming therapeutic recreation camps that have undergone modifications.

Adult Adventures

Adult Adventures is for adults with intellectual disabilities or neurological impairments who are able to function in a 2:1 camper to staff ratio. Campers must be able to take care of their own personal hygiene and adhere to our behavioral guidelines. Each day is filled with exciting activities such as: sports, games, arts and crafts, water activities, and more. Campers are grouped according to age and ability level. Adult Adventures offers 8 consecutive weeks starting on the week of June 22 and the final session is the week of August 10. Acceptance is based on application and interview assessment. Adult Adventures is an approved DDD provider under respite (day camp) for participants utilizing Supports or CCP Budgets.

Modifications:

- Activities will be held primarily outdoors with only some activities indoors.
- Social distancing guidelines must be able to be followed by all participants.
- There will be no camp show and no DJ dance party.
- If pools are required to stay closed during our time at camp, there will be no swimming.

Acceptance is based on application and interview assessment. Capers Quest is a CSOC contracted camp.

Campers are grouped according to age and ability level. Recreation Challenge offers seven consecutive weeks starting on the week of June 22 and the final session is the week of August 3.
