## Expected Standards of Behavior

The following standards of behavior have been set to enhance the safety and program quality for the participants and the staff. Please read, sign, and date and return this form. Failure to abide to these standards will lead to disciplinary action or dismissal from the program.

- **Behavior** - Participants must treat each other, program leaders, and instructors with respect at all times. Hitting, slapping, and putting hands on one another IS NOT tolerated.
- **Attitude** - Participants must be attentive to all program leaders when receiving instructions. Many of our activities require safety instructions and we need each participant to be responsible for him/her. Not every activity will be of interest to all, so please be respectful of other participants.
- **Verbal Expression** - Repeated use of inappropriate, disrespectful, or profane language IS NOT tolerated.
- **Contraband** - Any tobacco products, drugs, alcoholic beverages, etc. will be cause for immediate dismissal and police notification, if applicable.

## **Actions for Disruptive Behavior**

- **FIRST OFFENSE:** Inappropriate behavior will be addressed with the participant and noted.
- **SECOND OFFENSE:** Repeated behavior will result in staff notifying parent/guardian of inappropriate behavior.
- **THIRD OFFENSE:** Disruptive and/or repeated inappropriate behavior will result in dismissal from the program and written documentation of inappropriate behavior will be placed in participant's file.

We want each participant to have a positive, enjoyable and fun experience. All of our activities are challenge by choice. This means no one will be forced to participate in activities they may not feel comfortable trying.
