CAMP INFORMATION

Camp information should be completed through the ePACT Network and submitted to the Monmouth County Park System. Please watch for an email invite from Monmouth County Park System via ePACT Network to create your account. If you attended camp with us last year and you have an account, please watch for an email to review and update your account information.

DROP-OFF/PICK-UP

Please drop off your child off at Sunnyside Equestrian Center. Please do not arrive earlier than 10 minutes before camp starts or later than ten minutes after camp ends each day. Each day campers will need to be signed in and out. Campers cannot be released to anyone not listed on the Parent Pick Up list. A valid photo ID is required by all authorized individuals at the time of pick up. Campers should be picked up promptly at the end of camp.

REQUIRED FOR CAMP PARTICIPATION

- Campers are to wear long pants and sturdy, closed-toe shoes; sneakers are best
- Please have children apply sunscreen and bug spray before arriving at camp
- Bring a backpack that contains the following:
 - ▶ Refillable water bottle
 - ▶ Sunscreen, hat and bug spray
- All items should be clearly marked with your child's name
- Riding helmets will be provided. However, if your camper has their own helmet, please make sure the helmet is ASTM-SEI certified. Riding boots are also available if needed.

DO NOT BRING TO CAMP

- Personal/valuable items, including toys and electronics

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Camp will be held rain or shine. Our indoor facility will be used in the event of bad weather.
