Circulation Improvements and Related Site Work at Wolf Hill Recreation Area

PROJECT INFORMATION

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The disc golf course installed at Wolf Hill in 2014 has steadily grown in popularity. Increased use requires the flow of both park and disc golf users to be examined and refined. This project's main goal was to improve the existing trail system through extension, realignment, and connection of existing trail segments. Additional new trail lengths were added to create loops for users to access from the existing parking facilities. When completed there will be a half mile loop and a mile loop as part of the trail system. Through realignment the new trail system takes users around the disc golf holes so they do not walk through the middle of a fairway or near a basket. This will reduce conflict between users and improve the park experience for all. The project construction is estimated to cost between \$200,000 and \$250,000.

REASON FOR PROJECT: To provide more cohesive trail system for day users as well as minimizing potential conflict with disc golf users.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS: None needed.

PROJECT STATUS: ***Construction is underway. New pathways have been installed and old unnecessary pathways have been restored to turf. Repairs to disc golf tees are commencing. Project is approximately 50% complete.***
