



Monmouth County Park System Dorbrook Recreation Area Challenger Playground Partial Surfacing Replacement

PROJECT INFORMATION



PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Work includes the removal and replacement of rubber safety surfacing at the age 5-12 play area and in the swing area.

REASON FOR PROJECT:

The playground was constructed in 2004. Over time the playground surface material weathered through seasonal exposure and heavy foot traffic. In the past several years, the surfacing has been repeatedly patched to maintain playground safety.

DESIGN APPROACH:

Playground upgrades conform with all Federal, State and Local standards including ASTM F 1487-21, Handbook for Public Playground Safety, New Jersey Barrier Free Subcode and ADA. The surfacing selection prioritizes inclusive play.

PROJECT STATUS: The surface replacement is constructed by Whirl Construction, Inc of Port Monmouth, NJ.

**The playground will be closed for construction on or about
March 31, 2026 through early May 2026.**
