



Monmouth County Park System Dorbrook Recreation Area Tennis Court Reconstruction

PROJECT INFORMATION

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

The work includes reconstruction of the four (4) tennis courts located at Dorbrook Recreation Area.

REASON FOR PROJECT:

The tennis courts have experienced deterioration and show significant signs of pavement failure through extensive cracking of the surface. The structural integrity of the pavement has been compromised due to the age of the courts and the effects of freeze and thaw cycles of water infiltration into the surface.

DESIGN APPROACH:

All four (4) tennis courts will be milled and paved to provide a new structurally sound base course and surface course of asphalt pavement. The asphalt will then cure for 30 days to reach its full strength and absorption of oils present in the asphalt mixture. A surface coat of paint will be applied to protect the pavement and delineate the lines and playable surface for tennis. Nets will be re-installed, and the courts will be re-opened for play.

PROJECT STATUS: The project has been awarded to Keystone Sports Construction for \$260,000. Construction is scheduled to commence the week of August 18th with anticipated completion by mid-October 2025, weather permitting. The tennis courts will remain closed during the duration of the work. Visitors should expect some disruption in the construction area, including noise disturbance and odors during the placement of asphalt and surface coating.
