## Wondrous Winter Walks

Wednesday, January 3 at 10 a.m. Manasquan Reservoir Environmental Center, Howell - Meet in the parking lot. Wednesday, January 17 at 10 a.m. Hartshorne Woods Park - Meet in the Rocky Point parking lot in Highlands. Wednesday, January 31 at 10 a.m. Freneau Woods Park, Aberdeen - Meet in the Visitor Center parking lot. Toss on your winter gear and tag along with a Park System Naturalist and explore the serenity that is nature in the wintertime. Open to all ages; under 18 with adult.
