Historic Portland Place Tours

Portland Place, Hartshorne Woods Park, Locust

Tour this beautifully restored 18th century house and view exhibits that tell the story of the region's history and the Hartshorne family legacy in Monmouth County. Tours are limited to 10 persons and

may be suspended during inclement weather. Register on site at the Portland Place Visitor Center day of tour. *FREE!*
