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WIND & SEA FESTIVAL CELEBRATES THE BAYSHORE



PORT MONMOUTH— From kayaking to sandcastle building, the Monmouth County Park System’s upcoming ***Wind & Sea Festival*** offers coastal activities the whole family can enjoy. Held on Saturday, September 19 from 11 a.m.-5 p.m., this event takes place at Bayshore Waterfront Park, Port Monmouth. Visitors are invited to try fishing, crabbing, kite flying, seining, shell painting, and more! Festival goers can also see a sand sculptor at work, get their face painted, and go on ***a Selfie Scavenger Hunt***. The ***Wind Wolves Traveling Kite Show*** will be there as well as representatives from the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary, the New Jersey Kayaking Club, and the local environmental group ***Save Coastal Wildlife***. The Historic Seabrook-Wilson House will be open for the event. Other offerings include a children’s craft, displays, and food vendors.

Most activities are free but some may have a fee. Admission and parking are free. Parking is available at the Belford Ferry Terminal located at 10 Harbor Way, Belford. A shuttle bus will transport visitors to and from the ferry terminal to Bayshore Waterfront Park.
