TOUR THE MANASQUAN RESERVOIR BY BOAT



HOWELL— Look for turtles, egrets, herons, ospreys and other wildlife in their natural habitat during a boat tour of the Monmouth County Park System’s Manasquan Reservoir. Led by a Park System Naturalist, these 45-minute tours leave from the Visitor Center, Windeler Road, Howell. Tours are offered at the top of the hour from 2-5 p.m. on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, May 23-September 7. Wednesday afternoon tours are offered at 2 p.m., 3 p.m. & 4 p.m. from July 1-August 26. Evening tours are offered at 6 p.m. & 7 p.m. on Fridays, June 5, July 3 & August 7. All tours are weather and water level dependent.

The cost is \$6 per adult and \$4 per child age 12 and under. Life jackets are required and provided. **Please note that children must be two years of age or older to attend and able to sit independently during the duration of the tour.** Tickets can be purchased in the lower level of the Visitor Center on the day of the tour. Call 732-919-0996, ext. 4526, to verify tours are running as scheduled.
