### **MILLING DEMONSTRATIONS RESUME AT HISTORIC WALNFORD**



UPPER FREEHOLD— The Monmouth County Park System is pleased to announce that the 19th century gristmill at Historic Walnford, Upper Freehold, will resume demonstrations for the season starting Saturday, April 5. Held at 12:30 p.m., 1:30 p.m., 2:30 p.m. & 3:30 p.m., these demonstrations show how corn was ground into meal in the 19th century. Lasting approximately 15 minutes each, demonstrations are free and offered on weekends through November.

Besides the gristmill, the site also features the pre-Revolutionary Waln House, an 1879 carriage house, and an assortment of other structures. The site's historical buildings are open daily from 9 a.m.-4 p.m. ***Please note that the Waln House is currently only partially open to visitors due to ongoing repairs.***
