MILLING DEMONSTRATIONS RESUME AT HISTORIC WALNFORD



UPPER FREEHOLD— Once again visitors to Historic Walnford, Upper Freehold, will be able to experience the rumble, clack and whoosh of the site's 19th century gristmill. Starting on Saturday, April 4, the gristmill will resume demonstrations on weekend afternoons from 1-4 p.m. Held at 12:30 p.m., 1:30 p.m., 2:30 p.m. & 3:30 p.m., these free demonstrations run through November. Lasting approximately 15 minutes each, the demonstrations show how corn was ground into meal in the 19th century.

Besides the gristmill, the site also features the pre-Revolutionary Waln House, an 1879 carriage house, and an assortment of other structures.
