VOLUNTEER DOCENT POSITIONS IN THE PARK SYSTEM

LINCROFT— The Monmouth County Park System is looking for volunteers to become Docents/Receptionists in three locations. Are you 21 years of age or older and enjoy interacting with people? You may have what it takes to step into our newest volunteer opportunity. Duties include greeting visitors and providing information about facilities, exhibits, park history, upcoming events and on-site ecology. Other responsibilities may include light upkeep of facilities and exhibits. Volunteers are asked to provide a minimum six hour commitment per month. Docents are asked to attend an additional site training presented by Park System naturalists.

Once trained, volunteers will be placed at the Huber Woods Environmental Center in Middletown, Bayshore Waterfront Park Activity Center in Port Monmouth or the Manasquan Reservoir Environmental Center in Howell on weekends in half day shifts.
