ENJOY A ROUND OF GOLF THIS FALL ON A COUNTY COURSE

COLTS NECK -- Say goodbye to the dog days of summer and hello to a round of golf this autumn when the Monmouth County Park System's off-peak golf season begins on Monday, October 3. Its mild temperature and colorful foliage make fall the perfect time of year to tee off at a county course. Best of all, the Monmouth County Park System is offering earlier matinee rates at all six of its golf locations throughout the county – Bel-Aire in Wall, Charleston Springs in Millstone, Hominy Hill in Colts Neck, Howell Park in Howell, Pine Brook in Manalapan and Shark River in Neptune. These discounted matinee rates start at 1pm daily at all courses.

During the off-peak season, golfers can take advantage of the Friends and Family Golf Special and redeem their free loyalty rounds Monday through Friday (holidays excluded) after 11am. Looking to book an outing for a club, business or large group of friends? Group Golf Specials can be booked for Bel-Aire, Pine Brook and Charleston Springs golf courses weekdays after 11am.

Along with its beautiful weather, autumn also brings shorter days. Tee times at the golf courses are adjusted accordingly. Here is first/last tee time schedule for the off-peak season:

October 3-9

First tee time on weekdays (Monday-Thursday) - 7:30am

First tee time on Fridays/weekends/holidays - 7am

Last tee time - 6:30pm

October 10-November 6

First tee time on weekdays (Monday-Thursday) - 8am

First tee time on Fridays/weekends/holidays - 7:30am

Last tee time - 6pm

November 7-December 23

First tee time on weekdays/weekends/holidays - 8am

Last tee time - 5pm

Tee time reservations can be made online at www.monmouthcountygolf.org after the purchase of a Golf ID Card. A limited number of walk-on tee times are available.
