MILL DEMONSTRATIONS RESUME AT HISTORIC WALNFORD

UPPER FREEHOLD— The Monmouth County Park System invites area residents to peek into the past during gristmill demonstrations at Historic Walnford, Upper Freehold. Featuring an operating 19th century gristmill, the site hosts free demonstrations on weekends starting April 2 and continuing through November. Visitors can witness the mechanics of this spectacular piece of equipment as it grinds corn into meal.

While at Historic Walnford, be sure to see the *Creating a Coverlet* exhibit upstairs in the Waln House. Open through August 24 during regular park hours, the exhibit features three historic woven coverlets and shows how they were made. Historic Walnford's hours are 8am-4:30pm daily; the site is open year round. Admission and parking are free.
