Pool Repairs at Dorbrook Recreation Area

PROJECT INFORMATION

PROJECT DESCRIPTION:

Renovations to the Dorbrook Recreation Area “T” pool are intended for fall 2019. The pool was originally built in 2000, and is 1,820 SF. Renovation work includes replacement of coping, tile and plaster, repair of leaks, and addressing ADA accessibility non-compliance.

REASON FOR PROJECT:

The pool is structurally sound, though appears to leak from the expansion joints. The pool does not meet Americans with Disability Act (ADA) requirements for accessibility. Coping stones and tiles are loose. Plaster is showing signs of age and wear.

DESIGN APPROACH:

The pool remains popular for swimming instruction and day camps for children. Repairs will be performed off-season, and will allow for summer programming to proceed as scheduled June 2020. The repairs are part of the pool's general maintenance,

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The work is within the pool interior, and will not impact surrounding park area or waterways.

PROJECT STATUS:

The construction project is currently advertised under public bid. Bid opening is September 18th, 2019. Estimated cost of the project is \$150,000.
