**BECOME A VOLUNTEER DOCENT

LINCROFT — The Monmouth County Park System is looking for volunteers to become Docents/Receptionists in our two Environmental Centers. Are you 21 years of age or older and enjoy interacting with people? You may have what it takes to step into this exciting volunteer position. Volunteer docents welcome visitors and answer questions about on-site ecology, exhibits, facilities, and upcoming park programs. Other responsibilities may include light upkeep of facilities and exhibits.

Once trained, docents may volunteer on weekends in half-day shifts at Huber Woods Environmental Center in Middletown or the Manasquan Reservoir Environmental Center in Howell. Volunteers are asked to provide a minimum two shift commitment per month.
