**HOMINY HILL VOTED BEST PUBLIC GOLF COURSE
BY NEW JERSEY MONTHLY**

LINCROFT – Good news is always wonderful to hear, it’s even nicer to pass on. So the Monmouth County Park System is pleased to spread the word that its Hominy Hill Golf Course in Colts Neck was recently voted the Best Public Golf Course in the state by *New Jersey Monthly* magazine’s readers. Designed by golf course architect Robert Trent Jones, Hominy Hill is regularly named one of New Jersey’s top public courses. This well-maintained course has hosted two USGA National Amateur Public Links Championships and numerous regional tournaments.

According to Hominy Hill Superintendent Tim Mariner, “golfers love the private course conditions at public golf course prices.” After the mild winter, the course is in great condition and ready for play. The Park System has recently completed a massive bunker restoration project at Hominy Hill. Work was done on 36 bunkers to restore it to its original design. Hominy Hill is just one of the Park System’s eight courses that offer exceptional value for golfers.

New Jersey Monthly readers know that the Park System offers more than just great golf. They also voted Deep Cut Gardens in Middletown as a runner-up for Best Public Garden. Dedicated to the home gardener, Deep Cut Garden’s 54 acres of gardens and greenhouses are planned as a living catalog of cultivated and native plants to be observed through the seasons. The parterre features 52 varieties of roses with over 180 bushes. The Elvin McDonald Horticultural Library boasts a large collection of books, videos and catalogs

available to the public to browse. Programs on gardening are offered year round and can be found on our website or in the Park System's Directory.

Besides these Readers' Favorites, the Park System also offers parks, forests, wetlands/marine habitats, historic sites, recreation areas and conservation properties.
