Held from 9 a.m.-2 p.m. on Saturday, May 21, this event features amateur competitions and a demonstration by the Lockdown Skateboard Team. Adding to the excitement is music provided by DJ Foggy Notion, a performance by local band The Pure Thirteen at 1 p.m., and local skateboard and food vendors.

The schedule for the competition is as follows:

Beginner from 9-10 a.m.

Categories are: Ages 12 & under and Ages 13-16

Intermediate from 10-11 a.m.

Categories are: Ages 12 & under, Ages 13-16 and Ages 17 & up

Advanced from 11:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m.

Categories are: Ages 12 & under, Ages 13-16 and Ages 17 & up

Bowl Contest from 1-2 p.m.

Categories are: Ages 16 & under and Ages 17 & up

Awards will be given to the top three skaters in each category. All competitors age 16 and under must wear helmets. The cost to enter the competition is \$15 per person. Online registration is available at www.monmouthcountyparks.com. Onsite registration is cash or check only.
