AT BAYSHORE WATERFRONT PARK**



PORT MONMOUTH— The Monmouth County Park System is hosting a *Wind & Sea Festival* on Saturday, September 19 from 11 a.m.-5 p.m. at Bayshore Waterfront Park, Port Monmouth. This event celebrates the Bayshore with coastal activities including stand-up paddling, kayaking, seining, fishing, crabbing, kite flying, sand casting, shelling, nature walks and more. Children are sure to love the storyteller while visitors of all ages will enjoy great food, music, and free tours of the historic Seabrook-Wilson House. Most activities are free but some may have a fee. Admission and parking are free. Parking is available at the Belford Ferry Terminal located at 10 Harbor Way, Belford. A shuttle bus will transport visitors to and from the ferry terminal to Bayshore Waterfront Park.
