Held from 11 a.m.-5 p.m. on Saturday, September 19 at Bayshore Waterfront Park, Port Monmouth, this event celebrates the Bayshore with cool coastal activities. Visitors are invited to try stand-up paddling, kayaking, seining, fishing, crabbing, kite flying, sand casting, shelling, nature walks and more. Children can also listen to a storyteller, make a windsock craft, and sample the Park System's

Morning Playtime program. Visitors of all ages will enjoy great food, music, and tours of the historic Seabrook-Wilson House. Be sure to check out the professional sand sculptor creating coastal animals on the beach. Most activities are free but some may have a fee. Admission and parking are free. Parking is available at the Belford Ferry Terminal located at 10 Harbor Way, Belford. A shuttle bus will transport visitors to and from the ferry terminal to Bayshore Waterfront Park.
