MONMOUTH COUNTY PARK SYSTEM PLANS EARTH DAY WEEKEND

The fun starts Saturday, April 26 from 11am-5pm when the Manasquan Reservoir Environmental Center, Georgia Tavern Road, Howell, will offer crafts, hands-on activities, animal shows, exhibitors and short boat tours. Admission and parking are free.

The festivities spread through the county on Sunday, April 27 from 11am-5pm with small events at various county parks. Here's what is planned:

Celebrate the Shore

Bayshore Waterfront Park Activity Center, Port Monmouth

Discover cool coastal animals like whales, dolphins, crabs and even tiny plankton during this

interactive show-and-tell program. Tours will also be given of the historic Seabrook-Wilson House, which dates back to the early 1700s. Tours begin at 11am, 12pm, 1pm, 2pm, 3pm and 4pm.
