KAYAK ON THE MANASQUAN RESERVOIR

HOWELL— Bring your sense of wonder and come ready to paddle! The Monmouth County Park System is hosting several *Eco-Kayak Drop-In Tours* of the Manasquan Reservoir in Howell. Meet at the Environmental Center, located on Georgia Tavern Road, and join a Park System Naturalist on the water to explore this fascinating site. All equipment is provided during this program open to ages 14 and up (under 18 with adult). Single and tandem kayaks are available on a first come, first served basis. Novice paddlers welcome. Please wear clothing that can get wet. These tours are offered from 2-3:30 p.m. on Sunday, September 21, Saturday, October 4 and Sunday, October 19. The cost is \$20 per person; cash or check only. Tours can also be arranged for groups.

Friday, October 10 from 4:30-6 p.m.

The cost is \$25 per person for each session.

Wednesday, October 8 from 8-10 a.m.

The cost is \$30 per person.
