Held from 11 a.m.-5 p.m. on Sunday, September 28 at Historic Longstreet Farm, Longstreet Road, Holmdel, this old-fashioned country fair brings visitors back to the 1890s through games, music and entertainment. Crafters will be demonstrating the arts of rug hooking, lacemaking, weaving and more.

Shaw at 12:30 p.m. and performances by the Chorus of the Atlantic at 1 & 2:15 p.m. Once again “Phydeauz” Flea Circus and “Wahoo” Medicine Show will be part of the festivities.
