- This is the final rose show of the year for exhibitors in the area.

View locally grown roses and see how they are judged, consult visiting JSRS Rosarians on rose selection and care and take a tour of Deep Cut Gardens. Visitors may cast their vote for their favorite arrangement, which will be announced during the award ceremony at 3pm. This is a FREE event.
