

SUPPLEMENTAL RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING GROUP USE BATHING AT SEVEN PRESIDENTS OCEANFRONT PARK AS ADOPTED BY THE MONMOUTH COUNTY BOARD OF RECREATION COMMISSIONERS ON MARCH 23, 1993 BY RESOLUTION #R-93-3-23=92.

GROUP USE BATHING FOR MONMOUTH COUNTY MUNICIPAL RECREATION DEPARTMENT SPONSORED PROGRAMS

Monmouth County Municipal Recreation Departments having official Summer Youth Recreation Programs will be eligible to use Seven Presidents Oceanfront Park for casual day-use free-of-charge. The Procedure shall be as follows:

1. Group use available Monday through Friday
2. Group use is not available on holidays
3. Group use hours: 10:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.
4. Group must use special designated group-use beach.
5. Maximum number of participants per day is 200.
6. No more than four (4) busses per day will be granted a permit. All busses must use designated bus parking area.
7. Group must obtain a Group Use Permit 24 hours in advance of the group outing. Request for a Group Use Permit must be made on official municipal letterhead identifying the program as an official municipal-sponsored youth program.
8. Must be no less than one (1) counselor/supervisor per each ten (10) program participants.
9. Requests will be honored on a first-come/first served basis.
10. Upon entering the park, the group leader must meet with a Park representative prior to allowing any program participants to leave the bus.
11. Group leader shall meet with a Park representative before leaving the park each day in order that any problems can be brought to each other's attention.
12. Problems caused by the group may result in revoking that group's privilege to use the park.

GROUP USE BATHING FOR OTHER YOUTH GROUPS

Other youth groups may use Seven Presidents Oceanfront Park for day use as per the standard fee schedule and following procedures:

1. Group use available on Mondays through Fridays.
2. Group use is not available on holidays.
3. Group use hours: 10:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.
4. Group must use special designated group-use beach.
5. Maximum number of participants per day is 200.
6. No more than four (4) busses per day will be granted a permit.
7. Group must obtain a Group Use Permit 24 hours in advance of the group outing.
8. Must be no less than one (1) counselor/supervisor per each ten (10) program participants.
9. Request will be honored on a first-come/first serve basis.
10. Upon entering the park, the group leader must meet with a Park representative prior to allowing any program participants to leave the bus.
11. Group leaders shall meet with a Park representative before leaving the park each day in order that any problems can be brought to each other's attention.
12. Problems caused by the group may result in that group's privilege to use the park revoked.
