<p align="center">DCBHS Children's Mobile Response & Stabilization Services (CMRSS)</p> <p>Call the Contracted System Administrator (Value Options): If youth (up to 17 or 21 if previous system involved) presents escalating emotional or behavioral problems at home or at school; if there are mental health issues; if there are substance abuse issues; or, if the youth's placement is at risk.</p> <p>On-site visit within one hour of receiving the call from the CSA. Can de-escalate the crisis, conduct a crisis assessment, make community referrals; arrange in-home services; and, provide case management services for up to eight weeks.</p>	<p align="center">Family Crisis Intervention Unit (FCIU)</p> <p>Call If: The youth presents a serious threat to well-being; if there is parent/child conflict with repeated disregard for parental authority; if there are run away behaviors; if there is a pattern of repeated unauthorized absences from school.</p> <p>Available by appointment M-F, 9-5 & by telephone after 5 and on weekends. Monitors the family for up to three months. May petition the court if the family crisis continues and all services have been exhausted.</p>

<p align="center">Psychiatric Emergency Screening Services (PESS) - Child & Family Clinicians</p> <p>Call If: Minor, age 5-17 appears dangerous to self, others or property & parents are agreeable to an assessment of the potential for danger.</p> <p>Available to provide crisis assessment, intervention and/or consultation to agencies and school liaisons, hospitals and emergency rooms.</p>	<p align="center">Abuse or Neglect Only</p> <p align="center">Division of Youth and Family Services (DYFS)</p> <p>Call If: An individual is age 0–17 and abuse or neglect is suspected.</p> <p>The call will result in an investigation by DYFS into the allegations within 24-hours of the report. If the report of abuse or neglect is substantiated, DYFS will act to protect the child and may take legal action. If the report is not substantiated, referrals to local supportive or therapeutic resources will be offered to the family.</p>
