Monmouth County Shared Services have recorded cost savings across several municipalities in the multi-million dollar range. There are many outstanding projects currently in the upstart stages in the Shared Services arena. Much progress has been made and great opportunities exist for the future of the program.

With the direct leadership and supervision of Freeholder Thomas A. Arnone, shared services has spearheaded an effort to organize and facilitate existing projects as well as continue to grow and expand the shared services program. The County continues outreach to existing and potential partners in a focused effort to grow County-County, County to Municipal, Municipal to Municipal, County to Authority and other opportunities. Shared Services has created a centralized depository of documentation and information to service, facilitate and coordinate all County and Municipal departments and needs.

Through this centralizing and streamlining of the system, the County is equipped to better serve and facilitate shared services projects. The County serves as a "one stop shop" for any County Department or Monmouth County municipality that seeks to access cost savings through county provided resource programs or the ability to access a system in which they can identify a "match" and enter into a share services agreement with a neighbor(s) who is seeking the same savings in the same area of services.

In short, the viability of shared services has been proven through the significant reduction in expenditures required by local governments to deliver the required services to their constituencies. Shared Services works and can produce a positive reduction in costs to taxpayers and relieve budgetary stress while continuing and potentially expanding the routine delivery of services.

In addition, by participating in shared services through Monmouth County government, all municipalities save an enormous amount of time and additional taxpayer money on the legal, administrative, bidding and processing costs that cannot be readily measured.

Records Information Management (MUNI-RIM)



- Underwritten by **PARIS** Grant funding (2005), Monmouth County developed the **RIM** records management software to address the County's growing needs to manage paper and electronic records.
- As the municipality's records management needs greatly parallel the County's, the County extended access to the cost-saving web-based centralized software to all 53 municipalities.
- Participating entities can store and retrieve documents electronically, avoiding paper storage needs, greatly improving record inventory controls and reducing systemic costs. With expansion to support electronic content, **ECM**, the system now permits the storage of many file types i.e. PDF, Word, Excel, audio , video....
- **22 of Monmouth's 53** towns are active within the **Muni-RIM** system
- **2,295,373** pages are currently stored in the **Muni-RIM** imaging system
- **7,898** files are stored in the **Muni-RIM** ECM system
- **Muni-RIM** has been used to electronically submit **3,144** records-disposal requests



Records Information Management (Muni-RIM) Expansion



With the expansion of record retention schedules, the County **now** offers “**Education-RIM**” to all Monmouth County school boards.

Moving Forward: We are reviewing the development of some very important **Muni-RIM** enhancements:

- By further integrating the County’s **Open Public Records System (OPRS)** with the **Muni-RIM** repository, the municipalities can make records stored within **Muni-RIM** available to the public. In the future, participating towns can create searchable records on the County’s OPRS website.
- Additionally, a countywide **PUBLIC NOTICE PORTAL** will be searchable under **OPRS**. All county and municipal records that are placed in pre-determined folders within **RIM** will be immediately available for public access. This service is intended to provide the public with free Public Notice search capabilities across government boundaries.

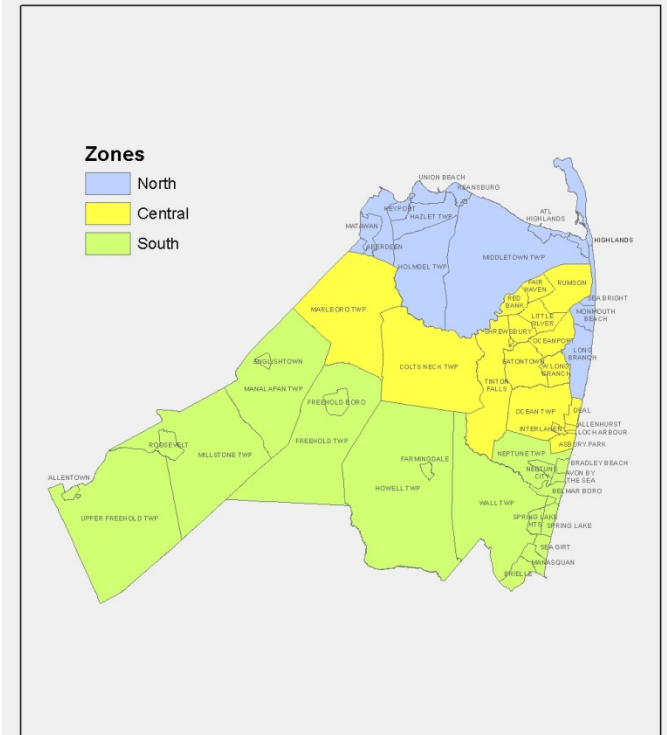

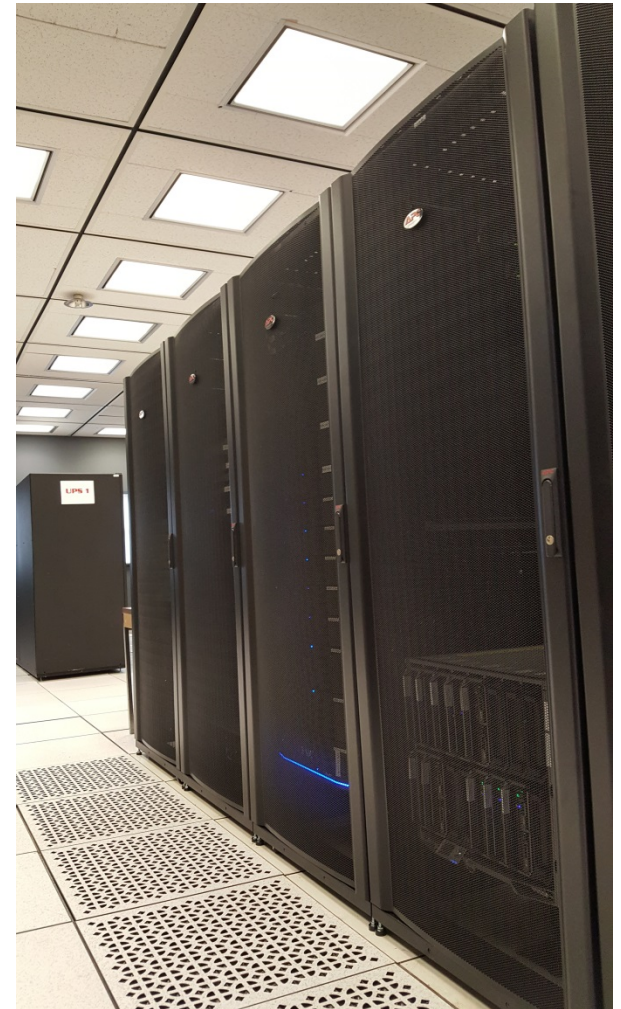

Tax Map Maintenance



Moving Forward, the Tax Board is exploring a **Municipal Tax Map Maintenance** shared service to provide for the efficient creation and maintenance of a countywide digital tax map and parcel layer for GIS.

Current law **requires municipalities to annually maintain municipal tax maps** and GIS systems are driven by the accuracy of the data layers.

N.J.A.C. **18:23A-1.27 Maintenance of tax maps**

(h) On or before January 10th of each year, every municipal tax assessor shall file with the county board of taxation, a duplicate copy of a municipal tax map which conforms to the block and lot designations reflected on the current year's tax list. **Each municipality shall provide for the preparation of yearly revisions of the tax map.** The municipal tax assessor shall be responsible for providing the municipality's New Jersey Licensed Land Surveyor with deeds and/or subdivision maps necessary for the revision.

By creating a shared service with all municipalities to **coordinate tax map updating through a licensed Land Surveyor**, municipalities can enjoy cost efficiencies and all parties can benefit from having up to date data for decision making.

Shared services produce a positive reduction in costs to taxpayers and relieve budgetary stress while continuing and potentially expanding the routine delivery of services.

In addition, by participating in shared services through Monmouth County government, all municipalities save an enormous amount of time and additional taxpayer money on the legal, administrative, bidding and processing costs that cannot be readily measured.
