

Mission Statement

The Friends of the Monmouth County Park System, Inc. is a non-profit, voluntary membership organization formed under the pertinent statues of the State of New Jersey. The primary purpose of this corporation is to assist the Monmouth County Board of Recreation Commissioners, the Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders, the citizens of Monmouth County, and other interested groups in meeting the objectives and purposes of the Monmouth County Park System. This includes recreational, open space, historical preservation, conservation, cultural, horticultural, and educational facilities and programming, specifically

to increase the Park System's value through donation of services, property (real and personal), financial assistance, educational assistance, scholarships and coordination of volunteer activities;

to enhance existing resources through funding and management of beautification, restoration and limited capital improvement projects;

to operate, manage and maintain facilities and programs;

to improve, expand and otherwise enhance park system programming through program development, communications, advocacy and advisory activities on behalf of the Park System;

to assist local groups which provide direct assistance to particular parks and activities, and to enhance the delivery of park services to groups with special needs such as the physically challenged; and

to solicit, collect, receive, hold and invest money and property from grants, gifts, bequests and contributions for the above purposes.

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954; shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any individual candidate for public office; and shall not operate for the pecuniary gain or profit of its members.

2010 Funded Projects and Programs

The Monmouth County Park System - The First Fifty Years - \$53,453

The Monmouth County Park System is a nationally recognized leader in parks and recreation. *The Monmouth County Park System - The First Fifty Years* examines how, from a small beginning in 1960, Monmouth County has preserved over 15,000 acres of open space, including some of the region's most significant natural areas and historic sites, and built one of America's finest county park systems. Written by Princeton author Clifford W. Zink and funded by the *Friends of the Monmouth County Park System*, this handsome keepsake hard-cover book commemorates the Park System's 50th Anniversary with 176 full-color pages and 423 photographs. Filled with first-hand accounts and historical images, the book illustrates the rich legacy of the landscapes under their stewardship. By taking an in-depth look at one county's efforts to preserve open space and provide superior recreation opportunities for all, this book elevates the relationship of parks and open space preservation to the quality of life in our nation.



Bayshore Waterfront Park, Port Monmouth - \$25,000

Phase II of funding was approved for the fabrication and installation of exhibits at Bayshore Waterfront Park. This project includes exhibits on the history of the Seabrook-Wilson House and the Bayshore community, and the ecology of the Bayshore region in four (4) rooms.

Historic Walnford and/or Historic Longstreet Farm - \$2,500

Funding was approved for custom designed and fabricated display cases for use at one or both of these sites.



Manasquan Reservoir Visitor Center - \$2,200

The Manasquan Reservoir Visitor Center boasts a new permanent water cycle exhibit.

2010 Annual Distributions

Holiday Trip & Semi Formal for Individuals with Disabilities - \$2,465

The Holland Activity Center in Tatum Park, Middletown was rocking on Friday, November 5th! The Friends were delighted to host the Annual Therapeutic Recreation Semi Formal. Young adults with disabilities enjoyed an evening of dinner, dancing, games, and prizes.

The Friends of the Parks also sponsored the Therapeutic Recreation Holiday Trip to Disney on Ice. The Friends treated 28 individuals to see Disney on Ice: Toy Story. This annual Friends program purchases tickets for the show and provides round-trip transportation for the participants and chaperones.

This year we were also able to pay for an outing to Seven Presidents Oceanfront Park in Long Branch. The group enjoyed a day of frolicking in the surf and sun.
