Volunteers (age 18 and up) are needed to monitor known nesting sites of least terns, piping plovers and oystercatchers. Learn more about this exciting volunteer opportunity by joining Christina “Kashi” Davis and Pam Prichard of New Jersey’s Fish & Wildlife for a ***Beach Nesting Bird Monitor Training Workshop*** from 1-3 p.m. on Sunday, May 6 at the Seven Presidents Oceanfront Park Activity Center, Ocean Avenue, Long Branch.

Volunteers that complete the training are invited to help monitor the birds over the summer and educate the visitors so that the nesting areas remain protected. Bird Monitors volunteer as their schedules permit, but are especially needed during peak summer usage and special events such as Fourth of July.
