HISTORIC LONGSTREET FARM'S HARVEST HOME FESTIVAL IS ALMOST HERE



HOLMDEL — Guess the weight of the big pumpkin, try your hand in the corn husking competition, or dive into the pie-eating contest at Historic Longstreet Farm's **Harvest Home Festival**. Held from 11 a.m.-5 p.m. on Sunday, September 24 at Historic Longstreet Farm, 44 Longstreet Road, Holmdel, this old-fashioned country fair brings visitors back to the 1890s through games, music and entertainment.

Visitors will have the chance go on a wagon ride, play old-fashioned games, and see ongoing cider making (12-4 p.m.), blacksmithing and woodworking demonstrations. There will also be crafters demonstrating the arts of rug hooking, felting, lacemaking, smocking, quilting, weaving and much more. Ongoing entertainment includes the Jugtown Mountain Band, Music Man Rich Marzec,

banjo player Lew Gelfond, and “Wahoo” Medicine Show and “Phydeauz” Flea Circus. Be sure to catch performances by the Chorus of the Atlantic at 1 & 2:15 p.m.
